Subject: Recreation Center Update

The Executive and Core Committees met on May 10, 2022.

During these meetings, the Committees continued to discuss the size and scope of the recreation center and its impact on operating revenues & expenses.

Also on May 10, 2022, the Design Team held a community-wide open house. There was a strong turnout for the open house with over 100 persons attending. There was strong participation from the aquatics and ice communities.

On May 23, 2022, Dusty Eaton updated the Billings City Council on the status of the committee's efforts. Additionally, people representing VisitBillings, the aquatics & ice communities, SBURA, the Senior Center and fitness center operators provided the Council with input on the recreation center. The feedback from Council was positive with an apparent desire to "go all in" with respect to the amenities offered.
